Overview

- ReSolve is very pleased to offer the opportunity to invest in or purchase the business and/or assets of Project Albatross (the Company), a waste-to-energy process facility.
- c.£12m has been invested into the development (which produces biofuel from vegetable-based cooking oil), including circa £8m in the site's physical assets.
- The Company operates from extensive leasehold premises (two sites on the same industrial estate). The two sites can each produce 160,000 litres of biodiesel per month. This is converted to electricity via the 10 biodiesel generators at the sites, and each of the two sites has a connection to supply 1.25Mw to the National Grid.
- The facility has been non-operational for some time, due to COVID-related supply-chain challenges.
- A further uncompleted site was designed to produce 1m litres of biodiesel per month, and it is estimated that this would require a further £2m in order to complete.
- The sites are located in Kent with excellent transport links.
